A new project for the Easter Break

Dear Parents, Carers, Governors, Friends, Staff and Pupils

The Governors have completed their judging of the "Stories in a Box" and the winners will be announced after Easter.

The children's response was fantastic and we have been quite overwhelmed with their enthusiasm. Even the Pupil Council requested regular repeats of the event.

This Easter therefore the children are being set a new homework task.

Children are asked to gather together photographs linked to either their favourite sport, favourite sportsman or woman or favourite sporting team. The pictures can be cut from magazines or from the internet. We ask the children to make up a collage/ montage of their images and

to glue them onto a piece of cardboard which is A4 sized.

The cardboard can be cut from a cereal packet.

If your child prefers, he or she can do a montage of all their sporting heroes or of all their favourite sports.

The A4 pieces of cardboard should be brought back to school on the Tuesday after the easter Holiday.

In school, the children will use the montage to inspire their own writing, which will eventually be put on the reverse of the montage and sent to our link school in India.

Parents of children from Y1 to Y6 are asked to support the

children in this Easter Holiday homework.

I hope the children will enjoy putting the collage together and will start to talk to their friends and family about what they would like to write about when they return after the holiday.

As in the case of the 'Story in a Box', there will be prizes in each class for the children who write the most compelling reports.

We are not asking Y6 to do this homework as they have a large revision pack to complete for the SATs, which are just two weeks after the holiday. They will however get the opportunity in the May half term holiday.
